A Parable

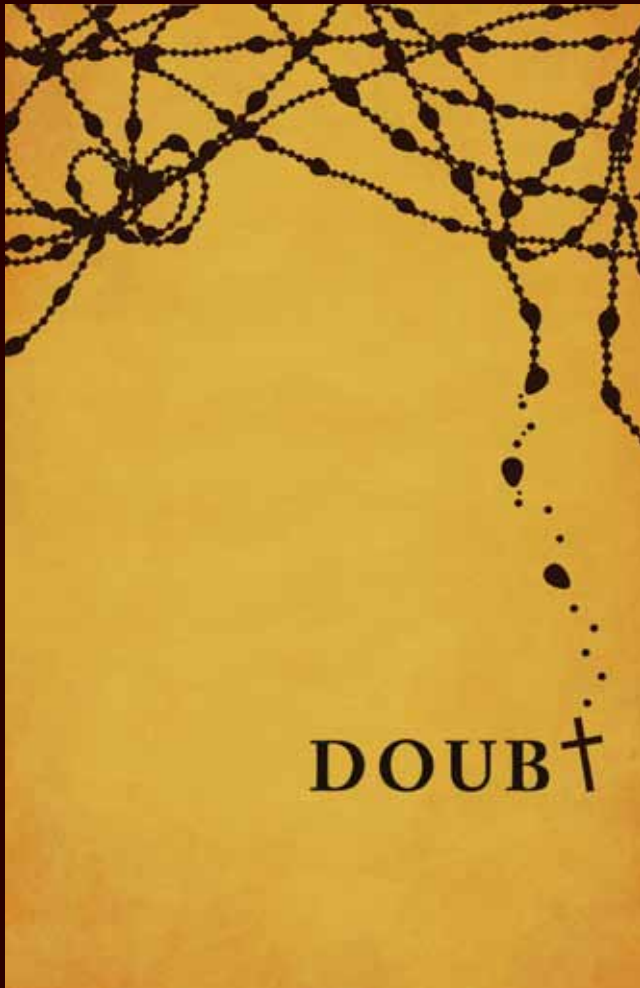

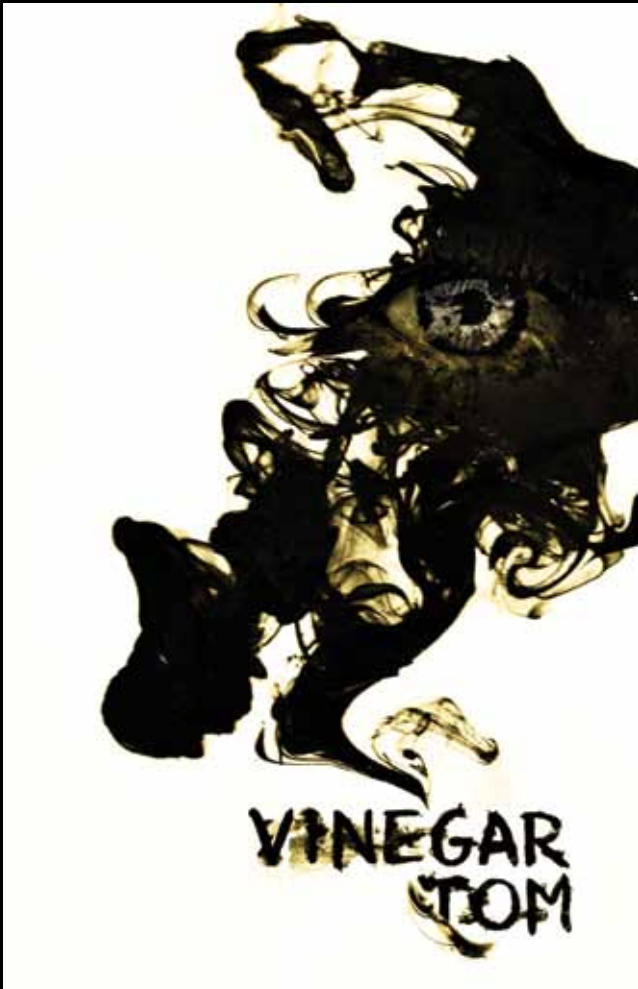
